"**Section 741.____.** (A) As used in this section, "benefits" has the same meaning as in section 4141.01 of the Revised Code.

(B) If the Director of Job and Family Services determines that an individual has been paid benefits to which the individual was not entitled for reasons other than fraudulent misrepresentation, the Director shall recover the overpayment in accordance with division (B) of section 4141.35 of the Revised Code, except that the Director shall waive collection of the overpayment if the Director determines that all of the following apply:

(1) The benefit was intended to compensate the individual for a week of unemployment occurring during the period beginning March 15, 2020, and ending the week that includes September 30, 2021.

(2) The individual who received the benefit was not at fault for the overpayment.

(3) Repayment would cause an undue hardship on the individual who received the benefit.

(C) If an individual has received a payment of Pandemic Unemployment Assistance under the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and

Economic Security Act," 15 U.S.C. 9021, to which the individual 21
 was not entitled, the Director shall recover the overpayment in 22
 accordance with division (B)(2) of section 4141.35 of the Revised 23
 Code, except that the Director shall waive collection of the 24
 overpayment if the Director determines that all of the following 25
 apply: 26

(1) The payment was intended to compensate the individual for 27
 any week of unemployment or inability to work during the period 28
 beginning January 27, 2020, and ending the week that includes 29
 September 4, 2021. 30

(2) The individual who received the payment was not at fault 31
 for the overpayment. 32

(3) Repayment would cause an undue hardship on the individual 33

Requires the Director of Job and Family Services to waive 37
 collection of state unemployment benefit overpayments and pandemic 38
 unemployment assistance overpayments if all of the following 39

--The benefit or payment was intended to compensate the 41
 individual for a week of unemployment or inability to work 42
 occurring during the periods specified in the amendment; 43

--The individual who received the benefit or payment was not	44

--Repayment would cause an undue hardship on the individual	46
