"**Sec. 109.731.** (A) (1) The attorney general shall 7
prescribe, and shall make available to sheriffs an application 8
form that is to be used under section 2923.125 of the Revised 9
Code by a person who applies for a concealed handgun license and 10
an application form that is to be used under section 2923.125 of 11
the Revised Code by a person who applies for the renewal of a 12
license of that nature. The attorney general shall design the 13
form to enable applicants to provide the information that is 14
required by law to be collected, and shall update the form as 15
necessary. Burdens or restrictions to obtaining a concealed 16



handgun license that are not expressly prescribed in law shall 17
not be incorporated into the form. The attorney general shall 18
post a printable version of the form on the web site of the 19
attorney general and shall provide the address of the web site 20
to any person who requests the form. 21

(2) The Ohio peace officer training commission shall 22
prescribe, and shall make available to sheriffs, all of the 23
following: 24

(a) A form for the concealed handgun license that is to be 25
issued by sheriffs to persons who qualify for a concealed 26
handgun license under section 2923.125 of the Revised Code and 27
that conforms to the following requirements: 28

(i) It has space for the licensee's full name, residence 29
address, and date of birth and for a color photograph of the 30
licensee. 31

(ii) It has space for the date of issuance of the license, 32
its expiration date, its county of issuance, the name of the 33
sheriff who issues the license, and the unique combination of 34
letters and numbers that identify the county of issuance and the 35
license given to the licensee by the sheriff in accordance with 36
division (A) (2) (c) of this section. 37

(iii) It has space for the signature of the licensee and 38
the signature or a facsimile signature of the sheriff who issues 39
the license. 40

(iv) It does not require the licensee to include serial 41
numbers of handguns, other identification related to handguns, 42
or similar data that is not pertinent or relevant to obtaining 43
the license and that could be used as a de facto means of 44
registration of handguns owned by the licensee. 45

(b) A series of three-letter county codes that identify 46
each county in this state; 47

(c) A procedure by which a sheriff shall give each 48
concealed handgun license, replacement concealed handgun 49
license, or renewal concealed handgun license and each concealed 50
handgun license on a temporary emergency basis or replacement 51
license on a temporary emergency basis the sheriff issues under 52
section 2923.125 or 2923.1213 of the Revised Code a unique 53
combination of letters and numbers that identifies the county in 54
which the license was issued and that uses the county code and a 55
unique number for each license the sheriff of that county 56
issues; 57

(d) A form for a concealed handgun license on a temporary 58
emergency basis that is to be issued by sheriffs to persons who 59
qualify for such a license under section 2923.1213 of the 60
Revised Code, which form shall conform to all the requirements 61
set forth in divisions (A) (2) (a) (i) to (iv) of this section and 62
shall additionally conspicuously specify that the license is 63
issued on a temporary emergency basis and the date of its 64
issuance. 65

(B) (1) The Ohio peace officer training commission, in 66
consultation with the attorney general, shall prepare ~~a~~ both of 67
the following: 68

(a) A pamphlet that does all of the following, in everyday 69
language: 70

~~(a) (i)~~ Explains the firearms laws of this state; 71

~~(b) (ii)~~ Instructs the reader in dispute resolution and 72
explains the laws of this state related to that matter; 73

~~(e)-(iii)~~ Provides information to the reader regarding all 74
aspects of the use of deadly force with a firearm, including, 75
but not limited to, the steps that should be taken before 76
contemplating the use of, or using, deadly force with a firearm, 77
possible alternatives to using deadly force with a firearm, and 78
the law governing the use of deadly force with a firearm. 79

(b) A foldable brochure of one page that summarizes the 80
information in divisions (B)(1)(a)(ii) and (iii) of this 81
section. 82

(2) The attorney general shall consult with and assist the 83
commission in the preparation of the pamphlet and brochure 84
described in division (B)(1) of this section and, as necessary, 85
shall recommend to the commission changes in the pamphlet and 86
brochure to reflect changes in the law that are relevant to it. 87
The attorney general shall publish a printable version of the 88
pamphlet and brochure that can be downloaded on the web site of 89
the attorney general and shall provide the address of the web 90
site to any person who requests the pamphlet or brochure. 91

(3) The attorney general shall create and maintain a 92
section on the attorney general's web site that provides 93
information on firearms laws of this state specifically 94
applicable to members of the armed forces of the United States 95
and a link to the pamphlet described in division (B)(1) of this 96
section. 97

(C) The Ohio peace officer training commission shall 98
maintain statistics with respect to the issuance, renewal, 99
suspension, revocation, and denial of concealed handgun licenses 100
under section 2923.125 of the Revised Code and the suspension of 101
processing of applications for those licenses, and with respect 102
to the issuance, suspension, revocation, and denial of concealed 103

handgun licenses on a temporary emergency basis under section 104
2923.1213 of the Revised Code, as reported by the sheriffs 105
pursuant to division (C) of section 2923.129 of the Revised 106
Code. Not later than the first day of March in each year, the 107
commission shall submit a statistical report to the governor, 108
the president of the senate, and the speaker of the house of 109
representatives indicating the number of concealed handgun 110
licenses that were issued, renewed, suspended, revoked, and 111
denied under section 2923.125 of the Revised Code in the 112
previous calendar year, the number of applications for those 113
licenses for which processing was suspended in accordance with 114
division (D)(3) of that section in the previous calendar year, 115
and the number of concealed handgun licenses on a temporary 116
emergency basis that were issued, suspended, revoked, or denied 117
under section 2923.1213 of the Revised Code in the previous 118
calendar year. Nothing in the statistics or the statistical 119
report shall identify, or enable the identification of, any 120
individual who was issued or denied a license, for whom a 121
license was renewed, whose license was suspended or revoked, or 122
for whom application processing was suspended. The statistics 123
and the statistical report are public records for the purpose of 124
section 149.43 of the Revised Code. 125

(D) As used in this section, "concealed handgun license" 126
and "handgun" have the same meanings as in section 2923.11 of 127
the Revised Code." 128

**"Sec. 2923.25. (A) Each federally licensed firearms 130
dealer who sells any firearm, ~~at~~ shall do all of the following: 131**

(1) At the time of the sale of the firearm, ~~shall offer~~ 132
for sale to the purchaser of the firearm a trigger lock, gun 133

lock, or gun locking device that is appropriate for that 134
firearm. ~~Each federally licensed firearms dealer shall post~~ 135

(2) At the time of the sale of the firearm, provide to the 136
purchaser of the firearm a printed copy of the brochure prepared 137
pursuant to section 109.731 of the Revised Code. 138

(3) Post in a conspicuous location in the dealer's place 139
of business the poster furnished to the dealer pursuant to 140
section 5502.63 of the Revised Code and ~~shall~~ make available to 141
all purchasers of firearms from the dealer the brochure 142
furnished to the dealer pursuant to that section. 143

(B) As used in this section, "federally licensed firearms 144
dealer" has the same meaning as in section 5502.63 of the 145
Revised Code." 146

Brochure on dispute resolution and use of deadly force 150

R.C. 109.731 and 2923.25 151

Requires the Ohio peace officer training commission to 152
prepare a foldable brochure that summarizes information, already 153
required to be prepared in pamphlet form under existing law, 154
that instructs the reader in dispute resolution and the use of 155
deadly force, and requires sellers of firearms to provide the 156

purchaser of a firearm a printed copy of the brochure.

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
