Federal, \$44,800,000 in fiscal year 2021 shall be used to 50
provide grants to child day-care centers and Type A or Type B 51
family day-care homes licensed under Chapter 5104. of the 52
Revised Code. Grant funds shall be used for ongoing 53
infrastructure costs and to help with increased costs to 54
purchase personal protective equipment and for costs or losses 55
relating to smaller class sizes, including previously incurred 56
costs, related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Grants shall be awarded 57
based on a center's or home's capacity to serve children and its 58
rating in the Step Up to Quality program established by section 59
5104.29 of the Revised Code. 60

Of the foregoing appropriation item 600617, Child Care 61
Federal, \$67,443,557 in fiscal year 2021 shall be used to 62

provide stipends to certain child care staff and administrators. 63
These stipends are to be retroactive to October 1, 2020. 64
Assistant teachers, administrators, lead administrators, and 65
other verified early childhood professionals are eligible for 66
\$300 each quarter of fiscal year 2021. 67

Federal, up to \$55,000,000 in fiscal year 2021 shall be used to 69
