marked date of the application shall be considered the filing 8
date of the application. The application shall be in a form 9
prescribed by the attorney general and shall include a release 10
authorizing the attorney general and the court of claims to 11
obtain any report, document, or information that relates to the 12
determination of the claim for an award of reparations that is 13
requested in the application. 14

(B) All applications for an award of reparations may be 15
filed at any time within three years after the occurrence of the 16
criminally injurious conduct, except as provided in divisions 17
