SYNOPSIS 20

Employers Providing Work-Based Learning Pilot Program 21

Section 3 22

Makes the following changes to the Employers Providing 23
Work-Based Learning Pilot Program created under the bill, which 24
expires two years after the bill's effective date: 25

--Requires the Administrator of Workers' Compensation to 26
adopt a rule that prohibits the Administrator from charging 27
against an employer's experience any amount with respect to a 28
workers' compensation claim if (1) the employer provides work- 29
based learning experiences for students enrolled in a career- 30
technical education program and (2) the claim is based on a 31
student's injury, occupational disease, or death sustained while 32
participating in the employer's work-based learning experience. 33

--Removes the requirement that the Administrator grant a 34
premium rate discount for an employer that provides a work-based 35
learning experience under the program. 36

--Removes the prohibition that prevents, for the program's 37
duration, an insurance company from increasing a premium rate 38
under a policy insuring an employer against liability for an 39

employee's injury, occupational disease, or death not covered by 40
the Workers' Compensation Law solely because the employer 41
provides a work-based learning experience under the program. 42

--Removes the requirement that the Administrator submit a 43
report to the General Assembly regarding the program. 44
