



Government Oversight Committee

Chairman Shane Wilkin June 17th, 2021

Chairman Wilkin called the meeting of the Government Oversight Committee to order at 9:12am in Room 121. The roll was taken and a quorum was present. The Chair moved that minutes from the previous meeting be accepted, without objection the minutes were accepted.

Chair Wilkin called up House Bill 294 up for its second hearing. The Chair called up Secretary LaRose to provide sponsor testimony. The Witnesses fielded questions from the committee and that concluded the second hearing on House Bill 294.

The Chair called up House Concurrent Resolution 21 for its first hearing. Chair Wilkin made a motion to accept Substitute Resolution Ir_134_0088-3. The roll was taken and with 8 yays and 4 nays the substitute resolution was accepted. The Chair then called up Representative Ferguson to provide sponsor testimony on Sub HCR 21. The representative fielded questions from the committee and that concluded the first hearing on Sub HCR 21.

The Chair called up Representative Cutrona to provide sponsor testimony on House Bill 243. The Representative fielded questions from the committee and that concluded the first hearing on House Bill 243.

The Chair called up House Bill 227 for its third hearing, Kristine Woodworth provided opponent testimony to HB 227 the witness fielded questions from the committee. The Chair then called up Randolph Roth to provide opponent testimony to HB 227, the witness fielded questions from the committee. The Chair then called up Rob Knisley to provide proponent testimony on HB 227. The Chair then called up Ben Prochaska to provide opponent testimony. The Chair then called up Douglas Rodgers to provide opponent testimony. The Chair then called up Pat Krummrich to provide opponent testimony to HB 227. And that concluded the third hearing on HB 227

The Chair then called up Senate Bill 80 for its first hearing, the chair recognized Mia Lewis to provide opponent testimony. Vice Chair White made a motion to favorably report Senate Bill 80, the roll was taken and the motion was passed with 8 yays and 0 nays.
