This bill cheats students, families, and educators of a quality-education and instead promote an incomplete, inadequate, reductive education that shuns intellectual curiosity and closes minds rather than expanding them. I want my children to be exposed to different schools of thought, to competing narratives, to controversial subjects in current events, and to learn about sexuality and birth control in a safe environment taught by qualified teachers - not on the Internet.
