

# FACT SHEET

- In 2020, the Food Bank distributed a record 15.6 million pounds of food in the tri-county area - including more than 5.2 million pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Each week, over 16,500 requests for food assistance are filled by 160 programs in Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull Counties. In 2020, of those who received food, 30% were children and 24% were seniors.
- The Food Bank partners with 41 schools in the tri-county area to provide food through the School Pantry Program. In 2020, students received food from the pantries nearly 28,000 times.

**For every \$1 given, the Food Bank distributes \$11 worth of food or approximately 6 meals**

## Mission

Second Harvest Food Bank of the Mahoning Valley's mission is to solicit, store and distribute food to hunger-relief organizations feeding people in Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull counties. Another aspect of our mission is to provide education and advocacy.

## HOW THE FOOD BANK WORKS

Feeding America secures donations from national food and grocery manufacturers and retailers and then delivers donated food to member food banks like Second Harvest.

We also receive food from local retailers, such as Giant Eagle and Sparkle Markets, in addition to donations through community food drives.

Second Harvest then distributes the food to 160 hunger-relief programs in our tri-county area. Such programs are church pantries, homeless shelters and soup kitchens, shelters for battered women and after-school programs that serve families, children, and seniors at risk of hunger.
