Chairman Baldrige called the meeting of the Transportation and Public Safety Committee to order 11:04.

A quorum was present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and were approved without objection.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 21 for its 3rd Hearing

- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 21. Ranking Member Sheehy seconded.
- HB 21 was favorably reported with 10 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 26 for its 1st hearing.

- Representative Richardson was called to testify and there were no questions from the committee.
- Crag Massie was called to testify and answered questions from committee members.
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 26. HB 26 was favorably reported with 10 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 30 for its 3rd hearing.

- Chairman Baldrige directed members to additional documents of support for HB 30.
- Chairman Baldrige recognized Vice Chair McClain who motioned to amend, amendment no. 134_0435-3. Without objection the amendment became part of the bill.
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 30. Ranking Member Sheehy seconded
- Amended HB 30 was favorably reported with 11 yeas and 0 nays

Chairman Baldrige called HB 31 for its 3rd hearing

- Seeing no questions or additional testimony this constituted the 3rd hearing on HB 31

Chairman Baldrige called HB 131 for its 1st hearing.

- Rep. Brinkman was called to testify and answered questions from committee members.
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 131. Ranking Member Sheehy seconded
- HB 131 was favorably reported with a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called up HB 104 for its 1st hearing

- Rep Stein was called to testify and answered questions from the committee
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 104. Ranking Member Sheehy seconded
- HB 104 was favorably reported with a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 119 for its 1st hearing

- Reps Sweeney and Holmes were called to testify and answered questions from the committee.
- Representative Loychik answered questions from the committee
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 119.
- HB F119 was favorably reported with a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 102 for its 1st hearing

- Rep. Holmes was called to testify and answered questions from the committee.
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 102. Ranking Member Sheehy seconded.
- HB 102 was favorably reported with a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 84 for its 1st hearing

- Rep. Jones was called to testify and answered questions from members.
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 84. Ranking Member Sheehy seconded
- HB 84 was favorably reported with a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called HR 13 for its 1st hearing

- Ranking Member Sheehy was called to testify and answered questions from members
- Chairman Baldrige called upon Vice Chair McClain who motioned to amend, amendment number AM_134_0135.
- Chairman Baldrige Ranking member Sheehy to speak to the amendment.
- Without objection the amendment became part of the bill

- Seeing no other questions or testimony this concluded the 1st hearing on HR 13.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 85 for its 1st hearing

- Rep. Jones was called to testify and answered questions from members.
- Seeing no questions or additional testimony Chairman Baldrige inquired on the pleasure of the Committee. Vice Chair McClain moved that the Transportation and Public Safety Committee favorably report HB 84. Ranking Member Sheehy seconded
- HB 85 was favorably reported with a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays.

Chairman Baldrige called HB 96 for its 1st hearing.

- Rep. Merrin was called to testify and answered questions from the committee.
- With no further questions this constituted the first hearing on HB 96
