
Dear Senate President Obhof:

It is my pleasure to present to you for the advice and consent of the Ohio Senate the appointment of Dorsey Hager to the Ohio Consumers' Counsel Governing Board pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4911.17.

The Ohio Consumers' Counsel Governing Board appoints the Consumers' Counsel and the Deputy Consumers' Counsel and monitors the operations of the Office of the Consumers' Counsel. The Governing Board consists of nine members, with three members each representing the following groups: organized labor; residential consumer; and, family farmers. The Revised Code requires that no more than five members of the Governing Board may be from the same political party. Dorsey Hager is a democrat and will represent Organized Laborers replacing David J. Wondolowski who recently resigned his position due to a conflict. Enclosed is his resume for your review.
