

**Testimony of Kevin Oney

In support of SB-52  
Ohio Senate Energy and Public Utilities Committee

Chairman Peterson, Vice Chair Schuring, ranking member Williams, members of the committee, I write as a proponent of SB-52.

I support your efforts in writing and trying to pass SB 52. I was elected to the position of Thompson Township Trustee in November of 2019 due to the tremendous support of the residents of Thompson Township here in Seneca County. The reason for their support is simple and obvious. The residents do not want industrial wind turbines near their homes. In fact, I defeated a well known, popular, and long time incumbent, because he supports the industrial wind turbines and I do not. I was able to collect 60% of the vote on my first attempt.
