Committee on Finance Minutes
June 8, 2021
134th General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Finance was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 2:15 pm in the Finance Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The minutes of the June 3, 2021 committee meeting were approved.
