

1) Strike the changes recently adopted that deal with the trusting/refund issues for caskets.

2) Declare that it is the intent of the General Assembly to review and consider changes to trusting law as it pertains to caskets.

3) To further this intent, the amendment shall require the State Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors to issue a report to the General Assembly no later than three months after the effective date of the bill containing recommendations and trusting levels in other states for funeral goods.
