Megan O'Callaghan Bio

Megan O'Callaghan is the Deputy City Manager/Chief Finance and Development Officer for the City of Dublin, a position she has held since February 2021. She formulates and executes strategic plans in areas including Finance, Economic Development, Planning, and Transportation & Mobility, a new division she created in 2020 to advance the City's Connected Dublin initiatives and align them with the transportation management strategies.

Prior to her promotion, she served as Dublin's Deputy City Manager/Chief Operating Officer and Director of Public Works. During her time in those roles, she oversaw many City departments and divisions including Engineering, Street & Utilities Operations, Fleet & Facilities Management, Parks and Recreation, and Asset Management.

During that time, Megan was responsible for planning and executing the City's Capital Improvements Program, which included many highlights such as her passionate involvement, oversight and project management of the Dublin Link pedestrian and bicycle bridge over the Scioto River. The unique and sophisticated bridge is a remarkable engineering achievement that has earned national and international accolades.

Megan is a graduate of the Ohio State University, where she earned her Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering degree. She attended Capital University Law School, where she graduated magna cum laude and earned her juris doctorate while she was working as a full-time engineer. She is a registered Professional Engineer and attorney in the State of Ohio.

Before joining the Dublin team, Megan worked for the Ohio Department of Transportation as a Deputy Director responsible for delivering ODOT's nearly \$2 billion annual construction program. She also previously served as Deputy Director for the City of Columbus Department of Public Service, where she managed 700 employees and oversaw the five-year Capital Improvements Program.

Megan is a member of the American Public Works Association and serves on the Department of Civil, Environmental and Geodetic Engineering Advisory Board at The Ohio State University. In November 2019, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine appointed Megan to the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors. She is also a member of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) and serves on the Northwest 33 Innovation Council of Governments.

In her free time, Megan loves hiking, traveling and spending time with her two children, Melanie and Jack. She also enjoys opportunities to work with the next generation of STEM stars such as participating in the OSU Civil, Environmental and Geodetic Engineering Mentoring Program and volunteering with the Girl Scouts.
