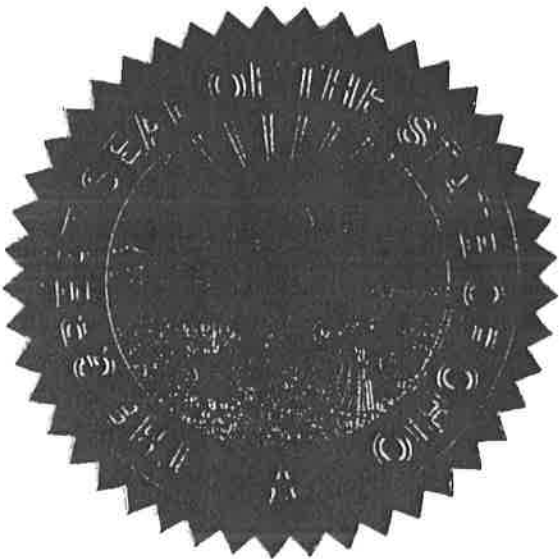

Robin Judd is Associate Professor of History at the Ohio State University, where she teaches classes in Holocaust Studies, Jewish History, and Immigration History. The author of *Contested Rituals: Circumcision, Kosher Butchering, and the Making of German Jewish Political Life, 1843-1933* and several articles and book chapters, she is completing her newest book monograph, *Love, Liberation and Loss: Jewish Military Marriages After the Holocaust*. Judd currently directs the History Department's Hoffman Leaders and Leadership in History Fellowship program and has served as the Chair of the History Department's Graduate Studies program and a Co-Chair of the University's Global Mobilities program. She is the recipient of seven teaching awards. She received her PhD in Jewish and German History from the University of Michigan in 2000.

An accomplished public speaker, Judd has lectured to a wide range of audiences across the U.S., Canada, Israel, and Europe. At the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum (USHMM), she organized the 2019 Silberman Faculty Seminar on Jewish Migration and the Holocaust and, in 2018, served as the Museum's Weinmann lecturer. In 2021 she served as a faculty advisor to the USHMM's *Experiencing History: Holocaust Sources in Context*. As a faculty member for both the Wexner Foundation and Camp Ramah in Wisconsin, she has spoken to Jewish volunteer leaders in Columbus, New York, Cincinnati, Houston, Aspen, Phoenix, Cleveland, Chicago, Milwaukee, and Madison.

Judd is currently Vice President for Programming of the Association for Jewish Studies, the leading Jewish studies organization with over 2,000 members in the interdisciplinary field of Jewish studies. She serves on the editorial board of the *Leo Baeck Institute Yearbook*, the premiere journal in German-Jewish studies, and on Academic Advisory boards for the Hadassah Brandeis Institute and the Leo Baeck Institute. She was previously the American Editor of the *Journal of Modern Jewish Studies*, the Vice President for Publications of the Association for Jewish Studies, and the Chair of the Race, Ethnicity, and Nation network of the Social Science History Association (SSHA). A current board member of the Ohio State University's Hillel, she also has served as President of the Columbus Jewish Day School and a member of the Columbus Jewish Federation (now Jewish Columbus).

The child and grandchild of Holocaust survivors, Judd is committed to researching and teaching about the Holocaust and working with local survivors in several different capacities. Judd lives in Bexley, Ohio with her husband, Kenneth Steinman.
