

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Judiciary Minutes
February 2, 2021
134th General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Judiciary was called to order at 3:45 PM in the North Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

Chairman Manning called up SB 16 for its first hearing. Senator Schaffer was present to give sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up all testimony on SB 13, written testimony was submitted by Ohio State Bar Association and Ohio Hotel and Lodging Association.

Vice Chair McColley made a motion to favorably report the bill to the committee on rules and reference.

Chair Manning asked the clerk to call the roll. With a vote of 7-0 the bill was unanimously passed.

Chair Manning called up all testimony on Senate Bill 4 for its second hearing. Lieutenant Colonel Kavanaugh was present to testify. There were no questions from committee. Chair Manning noted written testimony from Benjamin Feltoon.

Chairman Manning called up SB 25 for its first hearing. Senator Gavarone was present to give sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up proponent testimony for SB 25 and the following were present to testify; Ohio Alliance of Recovery Providers, Ohio Prosecutors Attorney Association, Wood County Prosecutors Office, and Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning noted written testimony from Attorney General Yost. Quest Diagnostics, Construction Employers Association and Associated General Contractors of Ohio / Ohio Contractors Association.

Chairman Manning called up SB 2 for its second hearing. No one was present to testify.
