Committee on Judiciary Minutes
February 23, 2021
134th General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Judiciary was called to order at 3:34 PM in the North Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 54 for its first hearing. Senator Gavarone was present to provide sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard. Chairman Manning called up Attorney General Yost for invited only proponent testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up all testimony on Senate Bill 49 for its first hearing. Senator Hottinger and Senator Sykes were present to provide sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up all testimony on Senate Concurrent Resolution 2 for its first hearing. Senator Rulli and Senator Hoagland were present to provide sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up all testimony on Senate Bill 16 for its second hearing for proponent testimony. Present to testify in person were: Chief James Price, Ohio Fire Chiefs Association, Chief Brandon Standley, Bellefontaine Chief of Police. Lou Tobin, Ohio Prosecuting Attorneys Association and Mike Weinman, Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning noted written testimony from; The Ohio Christian Alliance, Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police, Ohio Fire Chiefs Association, Police and Fire Retirees of Ohio, Ohio Ambulance and Medical Transportation Association, Northern Ohio Firefighters Association and Michael Melampy.
