

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Judiciary Minutes
March 2, 2021
134th General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Judiciary was called to order at 3:32 PM in the North Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 56 for its first hearing. Senator Blessing was present to provide sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up proponent testimony on Senate Bill 49 for its second hearing. Present to testify in person were: Karen Planet, American Institute of Architects of Ohio and Bruce Sekanick, American Institute of Architects of Ohio. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning noted written testimony from: Professional Land Surveyors of Ohio, American Council of Engineering Companies and Ohio Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Artists.

Chairman Manning called up proponent testimony on Senate Bill 54 for its second hearing. There was no one present to testify. Written testimony from the Ohio Association of Area Agencies on Aging was accepted.

Chairman Manning called up proponent testimony on Senate Bill 41 for its second hearing for proponent testimony. There was no one present to testify. Written testimony from the Prosecuting Attorneys Association of Ohio was accepted.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 36 for its third hearing for all testimony. There was no one present to testify. Chairman Manning noted written testimony from: Americans For Prosperity (proponent) and Office of the Ohio Public Defender (proponent).

Vice Chair McColley moved to favorably report Senate Bill 36 to the Senate Rules and Reference Committee. By a vote of 7-0, the bill was favorably reported to the Rules and Reference Committee.
