

**OHIO SENATE**  
**Committee on Judiciary Minutes**  
**March 31, 2021**  
**134th General Assembly**

The Senate Committee on Judiciary was called to order at 3:32 PM in the Finance Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 94 for its first hearing. Senator Wilson was present to provide sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 103 for its first hearing. Senator Huffman and Senator Antonio were present to provide testimony. There were no questions from committee members.

Chairman Manning called up the consideration of Governors Appointments for the following individuals: Mark A. Vander Laan - Ethics Commission, Scott M. Kent - Ohio Organized Crime Investigations Commission, and Angela L. Snyder - Ohio Private Investigations and Security Services Commission.

Senator Gavarone made a motion to favorably report the Governor's Appointment. Chairman Manning asked the clerk to call the role. With sufficient votes the Governor's Appointments were approved.

Chairman Manning called up all testimony on Senate Bill 54 for its third hearing. There was no one present to testify. Written interested party testimony from the Council on Older Persons was accepted.

Senator Gavarone made a motion to favorably pass and report Senate Bill 54 to the Committee on Rules and Reference. Chairman Manning asked the clerk to call the role. With 4 affirmative votes and 1 negative vote the bill was favorably reported to the Committee on Rules and Reference.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 82 for its first hearing. Senator Maharth was present to provide testimony. There were no questions from committee members.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 90 for its first hearing. Senator Kunze and Senator Antonio were present to provide testimony. Questions from the committee members were heard.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 49 for its third hearing for opponent or interested party testimony. There was no one present to testify and no written testimony.

With no further business the committee adjourned at 4:04 PM.
