

OHIO SENATE
Committee on Judiciary Minutes
April 20, 2021
134th General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Judiciary was called to order at 3:32 PM in the North Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

Chairman Manning called up House Bill 7 for its first hearing. Representative Grendell and Representative Stewart were present to provide sponsor testimony. Questions from the committee were heard.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Joint Resolution 1 for its first hearing. Senator Thomas was present to provide testimony. There were no questions from committee members.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 130 for its first hearing. Senator Antani was present to provide testimony. There were no questions from committee members.

Senator Gavarone made a motion to favorably report the Governor's Appointment. Chairman Manning asked the clerk to call the role. With sufficient votes the Governor's Appointments were approved.

Chairman Manning called up all testimony on Senate Bill 34 for its second hearing. Present to testify in person was Laura Battocletti, Capital Square Review and Advisory Board. Chairman Manning noted written only testimony from the Ohio Christian Alliance.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 49 for its fourth hearing. There was no one present to testify and no written testimony.

Senator McColley motioned to favorable report the bill to the Senate Committee on Rules and Reference.

With a vote of 7-0 Senate Bill 49 is favorable reported.

Chairman Manning called up Senate Bill 56 for its second hearing. Present to testify in person was Beth Easterday, American Council of Engineering Companies in Ohio.
