Committee on Primary and Secondary Education Minutes
February 23, 2021
134th General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Primary and Secondary was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 3:02 PM in the Senate South Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken and a quorum was present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved without objection, correction, or addition.

The Chair called up S.B. 37 for its first hearing.

The following testimony was provided:

Senators Teresa Fedor and Nathan Manning, Ohio Senate - Sponsor Testimony (In-Person and Written Testimony)

There was a brief discussion over federal guidance on testing that was released the previous evening followed by questions of the senators.

This concluded the first hearing on S. B. 37.

The Chair called up S. B. 1 for its 2nd hearing.

Senator Blessing moved to amend with AM0273 - which would extend exemptions for financial literacy teaching requirements given to ISACS schools to chartered, nonpublic schools as well.

The amendment was accepted without objection and became part of the bill.

Interested Party testimony was given by Barbara Shaner, OASSA, Jennifer Hogue, OSBA, Katie Johnson, OASBO, and Kevin Miller, BASA.

Written only testimony was provided by Jay Pascoe, Ohio Mortgage Bankers association (Proponent) and Sally Antonucci, Family and Consumer Sciences Teacher (Interested Party).

This concluded the second hearing on S. B. 1.
