Committee on Primary and Secondary Education Minutes
May 24, 2022
134th General Assembly

The Senate Committee on Primary and Secondary Education was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 3:15 p.m. in the South Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.

The minutes of the May 17, 2022 committee meeting were approved.

The Chair called up S.B. 306 for its fifth hearing.

No testimony was offered.

Senator Blessing moved that a substitute bill (L_134_2300-7) be accepted by the committee. The motion was agreed to without objection.

Senator Blessing moved that S.B. 306 be favorably reported to the Committee on Rules and Reference. The motion was agreed to by a vote of 6-0.

The Chair called up H.B. 583 for its fourth hearing.

The following amendments were offered:

Senator Blessing moved to amend with AM 3140 (Alternative resident educator licensure areas). The motion was agreed to without objection.
