Committee on Veterans and Public Safety Minutes
September 21, 2021
134th General Assembly

The Senate Veterans and Public Safety Committee was called to order pursuant to the meeting notice at approximately 2:32pm in the Finance Hearing Room of the Statehouse.

Attendance was taken. A quorum was present.
