BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3301.0727 of the Revised Code be	0
enacted to read as follows:	9
Sec. 3301.0727. If the state board of education selects	10
the assessments developed by the partnership for assessment of	11
readiness for college and careers for any of the assessments	12
prescribed under division (A) of section 3301.0710 or division	13
(B)(2) of section 3301.0712 of the Revised Code, school	14
districts and schools shall be required to administer only the	15
performance-based portion of those assessments and shall not be	16
required to administer the end-of-year portion of those	17
assessments. A district or school may choose to administer the	18
end-of-year portion of those assessments. The results of the	19

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end-of-year portion of those assessments shall not be used for	20			
purposes of calculating report card ratings and the measures and				
components that compile a report card rating issued under				
section 3302.03 of the Revised Code, evaluating teachers and				
administrators under section 3311.80, 3311.84, or 3319.111 or				
division (D) of section 3319.02 of the Revised Code, retention				
of third-grade students under section 3313.608 of the Revised				
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Code, or determining eligibility for high school graduation				
under section 3313.618 of the Revised Code.	28			
Section 2. Notwithstanding anything in the Revised Code to	29			
the contrary, division (E)(3) of section 3317.03, division (L)	30			
(3) of section 3314.08, and division (C) of section 3326.37 of	31			
the Revised Code shall not apply in the case of a pupil who did	32			
not take an assessment prescribed under division (A) of section	33			
3301.0710 or division (B)(2) of section 3301.0712 of the Revised	34			
Code that was administered during the 2014-2015 school year and	35			
was not excused pursuant to division (C)(1) or (3) of section				
3301.0711 of the Revised Code from taking that assessment.	37			
Section 3. Not later than thirty days of the effective	38			
date of this section, the Department of Education shall apply to	39			
the United States secretary of education for a waiver from				
provisions of the "No Child Left Behind Act of 2001," in order				
to implement section 3301.0727 of the Revised Code as enacted by				
this act.	43			
Section 4. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	44			
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	45			
peace, health, and safety. The reason for the necessity is that				
immediate action is needed in order to address in a timely				
manner issues related to the administration of state achievement				
assessments for the 2014-2015 school year. Therefore, this act				
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shall go into immediate effect.

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
