## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5301.072 and 5311.191 k	be amended 11
and sections 4781.401 and 5321.131 of the Revised Cod	e be 12

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Sec. 5301.072. (A) No covenant, condition, or restriction	39
set forth in a deed, and no rule, regulation, bylaw, or other	40
governing document or agreement of a homeowners, neighborhood,	41

(1) The placement on any property of a flagpole that is to 44 be used for the purpose of displaying, or shall prohibit or be 45 construed to prohibit the flag of the United States or the 46 national league of families POW/MIA flag; 47

(2) The display on any property of  $\tau$  the flag of the United States or the national league of families POW/MIA flag if the flag is displayed in accordance with any of the following:

(1) (a) The patriotic customs set forth in 4 U.S.C.A. U.S.C. 5 105 to 10, as amended, and 36 U.S.C. 902, as amended, governing the display and use of the flag of the United States;

(2) (b) The consent of the property's owner or of any 54 person having lawful control of the property; 55

 $\frac{(3)}{(2)}$  (c) The recommended flagpole standards set forth in "Our Flag," published pursuant to S.C.R. 61 of the 105th Congress, 1st Session (1998);

(4) (d) Any federal law, proclamation of the president of the United States or the governor, section of the Revised Code, or local ordinance or resolution.

(3) The display of a service flag approved by the United 62 States secretary of defense for display in a window of the 63 residence of a member of the immediate family of an individual 64 who is serving in the armed forces of the United States. A 65 service flag includes a blue star banner, a gold star banner, 66 and any other flag the secretary of defense designates as a 67 service flag. 68

(B) A covenant, condition, restriction, rule, regulation, 69 bylaw, governing document, or agreement or a construction of any 70

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of these items that violates division (A) of this section is against public policy and unenforceable in any court of this state to the extent it violates that division.

Sec. 5311.191. (A) No declaration, bylaw, rule, 74 regulation, or agreement of a condominium property or 75 construction of any of these items by the board of managers of 76 its unit owners association shall prohibit <u>the either of the</u> 77 <u>following:</u> 78

(1) (a) The patriotic customs set forth in 4 U.S.C.A. U.S.C. 5-105 to 10, as amended, and 36 U.S.C. 902, as amended, governing the display and use of the flag of the United States;

(2)(b)The recommended flagpole standards set forth in90"Our Flag," published pursuant to S.C.R. 61 of the 105th91Congress, 1st Session (1998);92

(3) (c) Any federal law, proclamation of the president of the United States or the governor, section of the Revised Code, or local ordinance or resolution.

(2) The display of a service flag approved by the United96States secretary of defense for display in a window of the97residence of a member of the immediate family of an individual98who is serving in the armed forces of the United States. A99

and materials of installation.	134	
Installation of a pole or bracket by a landlord or tenant,	135	
and display of a flag under division (A) of this section, shall	136	
comply with all applicable laws and safety standards and any	137	
patriotic customs contemplated by that division.	138	
Nothing in this division exempts a tenant from a provision	139	
in a lease agreement that requires the tenant, at the	140	
termination of a lease, to return the premises in the same	141	
condition as they were in when the tenant took possession.	142	
Prior to commencing any excavation for the installation of	143	
a flagpole on the grounds of the tenant's residential premises,	144	
the landlord or tenant shall notify a protection service, and	145	
comply with Chapter 3781. of the Revised Code, to determine the	146	
location of any underground utilities in the area of the planned	147	
excavation.	148
