### A BILL

	activities involving nutrition-related items and	3
	therapies, nonprescription drugs, and medical	4

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4734.15 of the Revised Code be	6
amended to read as follows:	7

Sec. 4734.15. (A) The license provided for in this chapter	0
shall entitle the holder thereof to practice chiropractic in	9
this state. All of the following apply to the practice of	10
chiropractic in this state:	11
(1) A chiropractor is authorized to examine, diagnose, and	12
assume responsibility for the care of patients, any or all of	13
which is included in the practice of chiropractic.	14
(2) A chiropractor may administer, sell, distribute,	15
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recommend, or provide advice regarding any of the following to	16
restore or maintain the health of the chiropractor's patients:	17

vitamins, minerals, phytonutrients, antioxidants, enzymes,	18
glandular extracts, botanical substances, herbal therapies,	19
homeopathic remedies, drugs that are available without a	20
prescription, or durable and nondurable medical goods and	21
devices. The authority of a chiropractor to engage in these	22
activities does not affect the authority of any other health	23
care professional, including a dietitian licensed under Chapter	24
4759. of the Revised Code, to engage in any of the same	25
activities.	26
(3) The practice of chiropractic does not permit a	27
chiropractor to treat do any of the following:	28
(a) Treat infectious, contagious, or venereal disease, to	29
<del>perform-</del> ;	30
(b) Perform surgery, or to prescribe or administer;	31
(c) Prescribe drugs for treatment, as defined in section	32
4729.01 of the Revised Code;	33
(d) Administer dangerous drugs, as defined in section	34
4729.01 of the Revised Code.	35
$\frac{(3)}{(4)}$ Except as provided in division (B) of this section,	36
the practice of chiropractic does not permit a chiropractor to	37
perform acupuncture.	38
(4) (5) A chiropractor may use roentgen rays only for	39
diagnostic purposes.	40
(5) (6) The practice of chiropractic does not include the	41
performance of abortions.	42
(B) A chiropractor who holds a valid certificate to	43
practice acupuncture issued under section 4734.283 of the	44
Revised Code is authorized to perform acupuncture.	45

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(C) An individual holding a valid, current license to	46
practice chiropractic is entitled to use the title "doctor,"	47
"doctor of chiropractic," "chiropractic physician," or	48
"chiropracticchiropractor" and is a "physician" for the purposes	49
of Chapter 4123. of the Revised Code.	50
Section 2. That existing section 4734.15 of the Revised	51
Code is hereby repealed.	52
