## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3105.172 of the Revised Code be 6
enacted to read as follows: 7

Sec. 3105.172. Upon the filing of a complaint for divorce, 8 annulment, or legal separation, the court shall issue mutual 9 restraining orders upon both parties to the divorce, annulment, 10 or legal separation.
