To enact section 3304.55 of the Revised Code to

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	
Section 1. That section 3304.55 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 3304.55. (A) As used in this section:	6
(1) "Blind" has the same meaning as in section 3304.28 of	7
the Revised Code.	8
(2) "State institution of higher education" has the same	9
meaning as in section 3345.011 of the Revised Code.	10
(B) There is hereby created within the opportunities for	11
Ohioans with disabilities agency the veteran and disabled Ohioan	12
technology council. The council shall do all of the following:	13
(1) Study and determine methods to improve accommodations	14
for individuals with disabilities through technology;	15
(2) Prepare a report that summarizes the council's	16
findings under division (B) (1) of this section;	17

(3) Beginning one year after the effective date of this	18
section, and every year thereafter, submit the report required	19
under division (B)(2) of this section to the governor.	20
(C) The council may adopt rules as necessary for the	21
conduct of its business. The executive director of the	22
opportunities for Ohioans with disabilities agency shall assign	23
one professional staff person to the council to serve as	24
<u>executive secretary and other personnel as determined advisable.</u>	25
(D) The council shall consist of the following nine	26
members appointed by the governor:	27
(1) Three representatives of businesses engaged in the	28
<pre>field of technology;</pre>	29
(2) Three representatives of state institutions of higher	30
education;	31
(3) Three representatives of the blind community.	32
(E) The governor shall make initial appointments to the	33
council not later than ninety days after the effective date of	34
this section. Of the initial appointments to the council, the	35
governor shall appoint one member who represents business, one	36
member who represents state institutions of higher education,	37
and one member who represents the blind community to a term	38
ending one year after the effective date of this section; one	39
member who represents business, one member who represents state	40
institutions of higher education, and one member who represents	41
the blind community to a term ending two years after the	42
effective date of this section; and one member who represents	43
business, one member who represents state institutions of higher	44
education, and one member who represents the blind community to	45
a term ending three years after the effective date of this	46

section. Thereafter, terms of office shall be for three years,	47
with each term ending on the same day of the same month as did	48
the term that it succeeds. Each member shall hold office from	49
the date of the member's appointment until the end of the term	50
for which the member was appointed.	51
Members may be reappointed to one additional term. Any	52
member appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the	53
expiration date of the term for which the member's predecessor	54
was appointed shall hold office as a member for the remainder of	5.5
that term. A member shall continue in office subsequent to the	56
expiration date of the member's term until a successor takes	57
office or until a period of sixty days has elapsed, whichever	58
occurs first.	5.9
Members of the council shall serve without compensation,	60
but shall be paid the actual and necessary expenses they incur	61
in the performance of their duties.	62
The governor annually shall appoint a chairperson from the	63
members of the council. The governor may reappoint the	64
chairperson to serve one additional term as chairperson. The	65
council shall meet at least six times annually at the times and	66
places designated by the chairperson.	67
(F) There is hereby created in the state treasury the	68
technology assistance fund. The fund shall consist of donations,	69
gifts, and contributions to the fund the executive director of	70
the opportunities for Ohioans with disabilities agency receives	71
from businesses and of any appropriations made to the fund. The	72
executive director shall use the moneys in the fund to improve	73
accommodations for individuals with disabilities through	74
technology.	75
