#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5160.471 and 5902.21 of the	7
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 5160.471. (A) As used in this section:	9
"Federal military-related health care benefits" means any	10
of the health care benefits provided by the United States_	11
department of defense or the United States department of	12
veterans affairs to current or former service members and their	13
eligible dependents, including the benefits provided through the	14
programs known as tricare and champva.	15
(B)(1) The department of medicaid shall review information	16

in the public assistance reporting information system to	17
determine whether an individual who is a medical assistance	18
recipient may be eligible for federal military-related health	19
care benefits. If the department determines that the individual	20
may be eligible for federal military-related health care	21
benefits, it shall notify the individual of the potential	22
eligibility and encourage the individual to contact the veterans	23
service commission in the county in which the individual resides	24
for assistance in applying for the benefits. The department	25
shall provide the appropriate contact information to the	
individual.	27
Sec. 5902.21. The director of veterans services shall	28
develop, institute, and monitor a program under which the	29
department of veterans services assists individuals, who are	30
medical assistance recipients, to obtain federal military-	31
related health care benefits. As used in this section, "federal	32
military-related health care benefits" has the meaning defined	33
in section 5160.471 of the Revised Code.	34
