# A BILL

То	amend section 3701.601 and to enact section	1
	3701.144 of the Revised Code regarding the	2
	administration of, and eligibility for, the Ohio	3
	Breast and Cervical Cancer Project.	4

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3701.601 be amended and section	5
3701.144 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 3701.144. (A) As used in this section, "cost sharing"	7
has the same meaning as in section 3923.85 of the Revised Code.	8
(B) The department of health shall administer the state's	9
participation in the national breast and cervical cancer early	10
detection program (NBCCEDP), which shall be known as the Ohio	11
breast and cervical cancer project. The project shall be	12
administered in accordance with Title XV of the "Public Health	13
Service Act," 42 U.S.C. 300k et seq., and the department's	14
NBCCEDP grant agreement with the United States centers for	15
disease control and prevention.	16
(C) In administering the project, the department shall set	17
eligibility requirements for services provided through the	18

<pre>project as follows:</pre>	19
(1) The woman must have countable family income not	20
exceeding two hundred fifty per cent of the federal poverty	21
<pre>line.</pre>	
(2) One of the following must be the case:	23
(a) The woman is not covered by health insurance.	24
(b) The woman is covered by health insurance that does not	25
include the screening or diagnostic services the woman seeks	26
through the project.	27
(c) The woman is covered by health insurance that imposes	28
cost sharing for the screening or diagnostic services the woman	29
seeks through the project that exceeds the limit specified by	30
the director of health in rules adopted under division (D) of	31
this section.	32
(3) In the case of a woman seeking cervical cancer	33
screening and diagnostic services through the project, the woman	34
must be at least twenty-one and less than sixty-five years of	
age.	36
(4) In the case of a woman seeking breast cancer screening	37
and diagnostic services through the project, either of the	38
<pre>following must be the case:</pre>	39
(a) The woman is at least forty and less than sixty-five	40
years of age.	41
(b) The woman is at least twenty-five and less than forty	42
years of age and has been determined by a physician to need	43
breast cancer screening and diagnostic services due to the	44
results of a clinical breast examination, the woman's family	45
history, or other factors.	46

(D) The director shall adopt rules for purposes of	47
division (C)(2)(c) of this section specifying the cost sharing	48
limit for each screening and diagnostic service that may be	49
obtained through the project. The director may adopt other rules	50
as necessary to implement this section. The rules shall be	51
adopted in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code.	52
Sec. 3701.601. There is hereby created in the state	53
treasury the breast and cervical cancer project income tax	54
contribution fund, which shall consist of money contributed to	55
it under section 5747.113 of the Revised Code and of	56
contributions made directly to it. Any person may contribute	57
directly to the fund in addition to or independently of the	58
income tax refund contribution system established in section	59
5747.113 of the Revised Code.	60
The director of health shall distribute the contributed	61
funds to the Ohio breast and cervical cancer project funded by	62
the national breast and cervical cancer early detection program-	63
established under the "Breast and Cervical Cancer Mortality	64
Prevention Act of 1990," 104 Stat. 409, 42 U.S.C. 300k et seq.	65
administered under section 3701.144 of the Revised Code. The	66
contributed funds shall be used specifically for the provision	67
of breast and cervical cancer screening, diagnostic, and	68
outreach services to uninsured and under-insured women who meet	69
the eligibility requirements specified in that section. The	70
breast and cervical cancer project, through its regional	71
agencies, shall first use the contributed funds to pay for	72
services provided directly by personnel of local departments of	73
health, federally qualified health centers as defined by section	74
3701.047 of the Revised Code, or other community health centers.	75
If contributed funds remain after a regional agency pays for all	76

screening, diagnostic, and outreach services provided by local

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departments of health, federally qualified health centers, or	78	
other community health centers, the regional agency may use	79	
contributed funds to pay for services provided by other	80	
providers.	81	
Section 2. That existing section 3701.601 of the Revised	82	
Code is hereby repealed.	83
