BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 4782.01, 4782.02, 4782.03,	6
4782.04, 4782.05, 4782.06, 4782.07, 4782.08, and 4782.09 of the	7
Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	8
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Sec. 4782.01. As used in sections 4782.01 to 4782.09 of	10
the Revised Code:	11
(A) "Primary care specialty" means all of the following:	12
(1) In the case of a physician or physician assistant,	13
family practice, obstetrics and gynecology, general internal	14
medicine, geriatrics, pediatrics, and psychiatry;	15
(2) In the case of a certified nurse practitioner, adult	16 17
<u>practice, family practice, pediatrics, psychiatric-mental</u>	1 /

health, geriatrics, and women's health;	
(3) In the case of a dentist, general dentistry and	19
pediatric dentistry.	
(B) "Qualifying educational loans" means outstanding	21
government or commercial loans for undergraduate or graduate	
education that are obtained and used solely for tuition and	
other reasonable educational expenses and for reasonable living	
expenses.	25
Sec. 4782.02. The director of health shall establish and	26
administer the Ohio health care professional loan repayment	27
program, which shall be modeled on the national health services	28
corps loan repayment program. To the extent funds are available,	29
the program shall provide grants to health care professionals to	30
assist in repayment of qualifying educational loans.	31
The program shall be in addition to and administered	32
separately from the physician loan repayment program established	33
under sections 3702.71 to 3702.81 of the Revised Code, the	34
dentist loan repayment program established under sections	
3702.85 to 3702.95 of the Revised Code, and the dental hygienist	36
loan repayment program established under sections 3702.96 to	37
3702.967 of the Revised Code.	38
Sec. 4782.03. The director of health may solicit and	39
accept gifts and grants to be used for the Ohio health care	40
professional loan repayment program. Any gifts or grants,	41
application fees, amounts received due to failure to complete	42
service obligations, and amounts appropriated by the general	
assembly shall be deposited into the state treasury to the	44
credit of the health care professional loan repayment program	45
fund, which is hereby created.	

Sec. 4782.04. The director of health shall adopt rules, as	47
specified in this section, for the administration of the Ohio	48
health care professional loan repayment program. The director	49
may adopt any other rules the director considers appropriate for	50
the administration of the program.	51
The rules shall establish the amounts of the grants to be	52
made to participants, service obligations required of	53
participants, and monetary penalties for failure to complete	54
service obligations. The rules may provide for varying grant	55
amounts based on the length of service obligations and whether	56
the service is to be full-time or part-time.	57
The rules shall specify the information and supporting	58
documentation that must be provided by applicants for	59
participation in the program. The rules may establish	60
application fees.	61
All rules shall be adopted in accordance with Chapter 119.	62
of the Revised Code.	63
Sec. 4782.05. The director of health may designate as a	64
health service site for the purposes of the Ohio health care	65
professional loan repayment program any health care facility	66
that provides outpatient primary health services to persons	67
residing in urban or rural health resource shortage areas	68
designated under section 3702.76 of the Revised Code.	69
Sec. 4782.06. The director of health shall accept and	70
consider an application for the Ohio health care professional	71
loan repayment program from any of the following health care	72
professionals who are authorized to practice in this state:	
(A) A physician who practices a primary care specialty and	74
has one of the following qualifications:	

(1) Certification in a primary care specialty from a	76
specialty board approved by the American board of medical	77
specialties or the American osteopathic association;	78
(2) Has completed, or will complete prior to commencing	79
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service, a residency program approved by the accreditation	
council for graduate medical education or the American	81
osteopathic association in a primary care specialty.	82
(B) A physician assistant who practices under the	83
supervision of a physician who practices a primary care	84
specialty;	85
(C) A certified nurse practitioner who practices a primary	86
<u>care specialty;</u>	87
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(D) A certified nurse-midwife;	88
(E) A clinical nurse specialist who specializes in	89
psychiatric or mental health services;	90
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(F) A dentist who practices a primary care specialty;	91
(G) A dental hygienist;	92

(I) A licensed professional clinical counselor;	94
(J) A licensed independent social worker;	95
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(K) A psychologist who has passed the examination for	96

Sec. 4782.07. To be eligible to participate in the Ohio	98
health care professional loan repayment program, a health care	99
professional must meet all of the following requirements:	100
(A) Be a citizen or national of the United States by birth	101

(A) Be a citizen or national of the United States by birth 101

or naturalization;	
(B) Participate or be eligible to participate as a	103
provider in one or more of the following: medicare, medicaid,	
and the children's health insurance program;	
(C) Have accepted a position at a health service site	106
designated by the director of health under section 4782.05 of	107
the Revised Code;	108
(D) Not have any outstanding service obligation for health	109
professional or other service to the federal government or	110
another entity that will not be completed before participation	111
in the program begins;	112
(E) Not be in breach of a health professional service	113
obligation to the federal government or a state or local	114
government;	115
(F) Not be excluded, debarred, suspended, or disqualified	116
by a federal agency for misconduct.	117
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Sec. 4782.08. Application for the Ohio health care	118
professional loan repayment program shall be made on a form	119
developed and provided by the department of health. An	120
application is complete only if it includes all information and	121
supporting documentation required by rules adopted under section	122
4782.04 of the Revised Code. The application must be accompanied	123
by any fee required by those rules.	124
Sec. 4782.09. The director of health shall consider each	125
qualified applicant for the Ohio health care professional loan	126
repayment program on the basis of the applicant's ability and	127
commitment to service to the medically underserved in health	128
shortage areas. The director shall select the program's	129
participants. The director shall determine the amount of each	130

grant and each participant's service obligation in accordance	131
with rules adopted under section 4782.04 of the Revised Code.	132
A health care professional who accepts a grant from the	133
program shall fulfill the service obligation specified by the	134
director. A health care professional who fails to fulfill a	135
service obligation without good cause shall repay the amount	136
accepted and pay the monetary penalty specified in rules adopted	137
under section 4782.04 of the Revised Code. The director shall	138
determine whether there is good cause for failure to complete a	139
service obligation. The director's decision is final.	140

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
