A BILL

То	require the Governor to complete a forty-hour	1

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) The Governor shall complete a forty-hour	6
externship consisting of on-site work experience in city, local,	7
and exempted village school districts in both the 2017-2018 and	8
2018-2019 school years. These forty hours shall consist of five	9
eight-hour days at five different elementary or secondary	10
schools operated by a city, local, or exempted village school	11
district. In choosing the schools at which to complete the	12
externship, the Governor shall, using the most recent report	13
card, select one school that has received an overall grade of	14
"A" under division (C)(3) of section 3302.03 of the Revised	15
Code, one school that has received an overall grade of "B" under	16
that division, one school that has received an overall grade of	17
"C" under that division, one school that has received an overall	18

grade of "D" under that division, and one school that has 19
received an overall grade of "F" under that division. If an 20
overall grade is not available, the Governor shall use the grade 21
for number of performance indicators met under division (C)(1) 22
(c) of that section. 23

At each school the Governor shall work alongside classroom instruction staff, food service staff, and custodial staff.

(B) Following the completion of each externship required 26 under division (A) of this section, the Governor shall submit a 27 report entitled "How to Make All Ohio Schools A-Rated 28 Institutions" to the President of the Senate, the Minority 29 Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 30 Representatives, and the Minority Leader of the House of 31 Representatives. The report for the 2017-2018 school year shall 32 be submitted not later than December 31, 2017, and the report 33 for the 2018-2019 school year shall be submitted not later than 34 December 31, 2018. 35

(C) This section shall expire on December 31, 2018. 36

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
