BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4503.29 of the Revised Code be	10

vehicle, or other vehicle the person owns or leases of a class		
approved by the registrar. The application may be combined with
