### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

<b>Section 1.</b> That section 2903.21 of the Revised Code be	5
amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 2903.21. (A) No person shall knowingly cause another	7
to believe that the offender will cause serious physical harm to	8
the person or property of the other person, the other person's	9
unborn, or a member of the other person's immediate family. In	10
addition to any other basis for the other person's belief that	11
the offender will cause serious physical harm to the person or	12
property of the other person, the other person's unborn, or a	13
member of the other person's immediate family, the other	14
person's belief may be based on words or conduct of the offender	15
that are directed at or identify a corporation, association, or	16
other organization that employs the other person or to which the	17
other person belongs.	18

(B) Whoever violates this section is guilty of aggravated	19	
menacing. Except	20	
(1) Except as otherwise provided in this division,	21	
aggravated menacing is a misdemeanor of the first degree. If	22	
(2) If the victim of the offense is an officer or employee	23	
of a public children services agency or a private child placing	24	
agency and the offense relates to the officer's or employee's	25	
performance or anticipated performance of official	26	
responsibilities or duties, aggravated menacing is a felony of	27	
the fifth degree or, if the offender previously has been	28	
convicted of or pleaded guilty to an offense of violence, the	29	
victim of that prior offense was an officer or employee of a	30	
public children services agency or private child placing agency,	31	
and that prior offense related to the officer's or employee's		
performance or anticipated performance of official		
responsibilities or duties, a felony of the fourth degree.	34	
(3) If the victim of the offense is a utility worker whom	35	
the offender knows or has reasonable cause to know is a utility	36	
worker, if the victim is engaged in the performance of the		
victim's duties, and if the offender threatens the victim with a		
deadly weapon with intent to obstruct the operation of a	39	
utility, aggravated menacing is a felony of the fourth degree.	40	
(C) As used in this section, "organization":	41	
(1) "Organization" includes an entity that is a	42

(2) "Utility worker" means an employee of a person or	44	
entity whose primary responsibility is the operation or		
maintenance of a utility.
