BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section	4
4503.909 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	5

The services 546 provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 547 defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 548 counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 549 violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 550 The school district superintendent or, in the school district 551 superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 552 appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 553
