| Section 1. That sections 923.41, 923.48, and 923.51 of the | 7 |

| (A) "Animal" means any animate being, other than a human. | 11 |
| (B) "Commercial feed" or "feed" means all materials, | 12 |
| except unmixed whole seeds or physically altered entire unmixed | 13 |
| seeds, that are not adulterated and that are distributed for use | 14 |
| as feed or for mixing in feed for animals. "Commercial feed" or | 15 |
| "feed" does not include drugs that are not incorporated into | 16 |
| feed and that are not distributed to be mixed in feed. | 17 |
| "Commercial feed" and "feed" also does not include negligible | 18 |
| amounts of feed ingredients added to a drug solely for the | 19 |

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| purpose of facilitating administration of the drug to an animal. | 20 |
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| (C) "Feed ingredient" means each of the constituent | 21 |

| (D) "Customer-formula feed" means a commercial feed that | 23 |
| consists of a mixture of commercial feeds, feed ingredients, or | 24 |
| both, each batch of which is manufactured according to the | 25 |

| (E) "Mineral feed" means a commercial feed intended to | 27 |
| supply primarily mineral elements or inorganic nutrients. | 28 |
| (F) "Drug" means any article intended for use in the | 29 |
| diagnosis, cure, mitigation, treatment, or prevention of | 30 |
| infectious disease in animals or any article other than feed | 31 |

| (G) "Brand name" means any word, name, symbol, or device, | 34 |
