## A BILL

То	amend sections 5722.14 and 5723.04, to enact	1
	section 5723.20, and to repeal section 5722.13	2
	of the Revised Code to give county auditors more	3
	discretion with respect to how often tax-	4
	forfeited land shall be offered for sale, to	5
	expressly immunize counties from civil liability	6
	in connection with such land, and to remove a	7
	requirement that property held by a land bank	8
	for more than fifteen years must be offered for	9
	sale at a public auction.	10

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5722.14 and 5723.04 be amended	11
and section 5723.20 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as	12
follows:	13
Sec. 5722.14. If nonproductive land is subsequently	14
included within an impacted cities project, as defined in	15
section 1728.01 of the Revised Code, taxes on the land in the	16
base period of the year immediately preceding the initial	17
acquisition, as provided in section 1728.111 of the Revised	18

Code, shall be determined by applying the land valuation as it19existed in either the year preceding such initial acquisition,20or in the next succeeding year after such nonproductive land is21sold pursuant to section 5722.07 or 5722.13 of the Revised Code,22whichever valuation is greater.23

This section does not apply to nonproductive land acquired and held by a county land reutilization corporation.

Sec. 5723.04. (A) The county auditor shall maintain a list 26 of forfeited lands and shall may offer such lands for sale 27 annually, or more frequently if when the auditor determines that 28 more frequent sales are a sale is necessary. 29

(B) Notwithstanding division (A) of this section, upon the 30 request of a county land reutilization corporation organized 31 under Chapter 1724. of the Revised Code, the county auditor 32 shall promptly transfer to such corporation, by auditor's deed, 33 the fee simple title to a parcel on the list of forfeited lands, 34 which shall pass to such corporation free and clear of all 35 taxes, assessments, charges, penalties, interest, and costs. 36 Subject to division (C) of this section, any subordinate liens 37 shall be deemed fully and forever satisfied and discharged. Upon 38 such request, the land is deemed sold by the state for no 39 consideration. The county land reutilization corporation shall 40 file the deed for recording. 41

(C) When title to a parcel of land upon which a lien has 42 been placed under section 715.261, 743.04, or 6119.06 of the 43 Revised Code is transferred to a county land reutilization 44 corporation under this section, the lien on the parcel shall be 45 extinguished if the lien is for costs or charges that were 46 incurred before the date of the transfer to the corporation and 47 if the corporation did not incur the costs or charges, 48

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regardless of whether the lien was attached or the costs or 49 charges were certified before the date of transfer. In such a 50 case, the corporation and its successors in title shall take 51 title to the property free and clear of any such lien and shall 52 be immune from liability in any action to collect such costs or 53 charges. 54

If a county land reutilization corporation takes title to 55 property before any costs or charges have been certified or any 56 lien has been placed with respect to the property under section 57 715.261, 743.04, or 6119.06 of the Revised Code, the corporation 58 shall be deemed a bona fide purchaser for value without 59 knowledge of such costs or lien, regardless of whether the 60 corporation had actual or constructive knowledge of the costs or 61 lien, and any such lien shall be void and unenforceable against 62 the corporation and its successors in title. 63

Sec. 5723.20. No county or its officers or employees shall\_ 64 be liable for damages, or subject to equitable remedies, for 65 violation of sections 3737.87 to 3737.891 of the Revised Code or 66 Chapter 3704., 3734., 3745., 3746., 3750., 3751., 3752., 6101., 67 or 6111. of the Revised Code or any rule adopted or order, 68 permit, license, variance, or plan approval issued under any of 69 those chapters in connection with property forfeited to the 70 state under this chapter. 71

Section 2. That existing sections 5722.14 and 5723.04 and72section 5722.13 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed.73
