To enact section 9.64 of the Revised Code to cease	1
payments to a subdivision that materially	2
hinders or prevents its personnel from carrying	3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 9.64 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 9.64. (A) As used in this section, "subdivision"	7
means a municipal corporation, township, or county.	8
(B) No subdivision shall enact or maintain an ordinance,	9
policy, directive, rule, or resolution that would materially	10
hinder or prevent an officer or employee of that subdivision	11
from doing either of the following:	12
(1) Obtaining, maintaining, or accessing naloxone;	13
(2) Administering naloxone to an individual who is	14
apparently experiencing an opioid-related overdose.	15
(C) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no funds in	16
the possession or custody of the state shall be disbursed to a	17
subdivision that is in violation of division (B) of this	18

section.	19
(D) This section has no impact on a subdivision resident	20
obtaining payment from the state.	21
