BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 6109.122 of the Revised Code be	8
enacted to read as follows:	9
Sec. 6109.122. (A) As used in this section, "school" and	10
"local board of health" have the same meanings as in section	11
6109.121 of the Revised Code.	12
(B) Not later than thirty days after the effective date of	13
this section, the director of environmental protection shall	14
adopt rules in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code	15
requiring each school in this state that is not subject to	16
section 6109.121 of the Revised Code to be annually tested for	17
lead in the school's drinking water.	18
(C) The rules shall establish all of the following:	19

(1) Testing standards and procedures;	
(2) A requirement that local boards of health conduct the	21
annual testing;	22
(3) A requirement that the director publish the results of	23
the annual test as soon as they are available;	24
(4) Remediation requirements applicable to a school when	25
an annual test indicates that the school's drinking water	26
exceeds applicable standards for lead in drinking water. The	27
remediation requirements shall include at least the following:	28
(a) A requirement that the school immediately provide	29
bottled drinking water to its students, faculty, and visitors;	30
(b) A requirement that the school develop a plan, in	31
consultation with the director, to bring the school's drinking	32
water into compliance with applicable standards;	33
(c) A requirement that the school implement the plan;	34
(d) A requirement that the school close drinking water	35
fountains in the school until the remediation plan is	36
implemented.	37
(5) Any other procedures or requirements that the director	38
determines are necessary to implement this section.	39
Section 2. This act shall be known as the State Water	40
Quality Act for Kids.	41
Section 3. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	42
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	43
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to	44
protect the health and safety of the school children of this	45
state. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.	46
