A BILL

To amend section 3313.719 and to enact section	1
3345.371 of the Revised Code to enact the	2
"Allison Rose Suhy Act" with regard to food	3
allergy training for public schools and	4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3313.719 be amended and section	6
3345.371 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 3313.719.(A) The board of education of each city,	8
local, exempted village, and joint vocational school district	9
and the governing authority of each chartered nonpublic school	10
shall establish a written policy with respect to protecting	11
students with peanut or other food allergies. The policy shall	12
be developed in consultation with parents, school nurses and	13
other school employees, school volunteers, students, and	14
community members.	15
(B) Each school district board shall create training for	16
all staff members and age-appropriate instruction for students	17
in grades kindergarten through twelve on food allergies and ways	18

in which to assist an individual experiencing an allergic 19 20 reaction. (C) Training completed under division (B) of this section 21 shall qualify as a professional development activity for the 22 renewal of educator licenses, in addition to activities approved 23 by local professional development committees under division (F) 24 of section 3319.22 of the Revised Code. 25 Sec. 3345.371. (A) Not later than one year after the 26 effective date of this section, each state institution of higher 27 education, as defined in section 3345.011 of the Revised Code, 28 shall develop and implement a policy to educate students and 29 staff on food allergies and ways in which to assist an 30 individual experiencing an allergic reaction. 31 (B) Each state institution of higher education shall 32 provide all incoming students and staff with information about 33 food allergies including available campus resources. The 34 information provided to students and staff shall include ways to 35 help prevent death as a result of an allergic reaction. 36 (C) The information prescribed by division (A) of this 37 section shall be posted on the web site of each state 38 institution of higher education. 39 Section 2. That existing section 3313.719 of the Revised 40 Code is hereby repealed. 41 Section 3. This act shall be known as the "Allison Rose 42 Suhy Act" in honor of Allison Rose Suhy. 43
