The Director of Administrative Services, in consultation with the Secretary of State, shall calculate a portion of appropriation item C100XX, Voting Machine Replacements, to be allocated to each board of elections in proportion to the number of registered voters in each county as recorded in the statewide voter registration database as of July 1, 2017. The Office of Procurement Services shall use the funding allocated to each board for the purchase of voting machines in accordance with either of the following:

(A) For voting machines to be purchased after the effective date of this section, upon request by a board of elections, the Secretary of State shall provide a list of the vendors and voting machines certified in accordance with section 3506.05 of the Revised Code. The board of elections shall select voting machines from this list and notify the Office of Procurement Services of its selection. The Office shall purchase the selected voting machines and any other necessary equipment or services on behalf of the board of elections and shall transfer custody of the voting machines to the board of elections.

The board of elections shall enter into a memorandum of
understanding with the Department of Administrative Services and
the board of county commissioners concerning these purchases.

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The board of elections shall be responsible for twenty per cent
of the purchase cost of those voting machines and associated
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services and equipment as determined by the Director of
