BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3309.374 of the Revised Code be	7
amended to read as follows:	8
Sec. 3309.374. (A) The school employees retirement board	9
shall may annually increase each allowance, pension, or benefit	10
payable under this chapter by three . If an increase is granted,	11
each allowance, pension, or benefit payable under this chapter	12
shall be increased by any percentage increase in the consumer	13
price index, not to exceed two and one-half per cent, except	14
that no as determined by the United States bureau of labor	15
statistics (U.S. city average for urban wage earners and	16
clerical workers: "all items 1982-84=100") for the twelve-month	17
period ending on the thirtieth day of June of the immediately	18
preceding calendar year. No increase shall be granted for a	19

period in which the consumer price index did not increase.	
No allowance, pension, or benefit shall exceed the limit	21
established by section 415 of the "Internal Revenue Code of	22
1986," 100 Stat. 2085, 26 U.S.C.A. 415, as amended.	23
The first increase is payable to all persons becoming	24
eligible after June 30, 1971, upon such persons receiving an	25
allowance, pension, or benefit for twelve months.	26
The increased amount is payable for the ensuing twelve-	27
month period or until the next increase is granted under this	28
section, whichever is later. Subsequent increases shall be	29
determined from the date of the first increase paid to the	30
former member in the case of an allowance being paid a	31
beneficiary under an option, or from the date of the first	32
increase to the survivor first receiving an allowance or benefit	33
in the case of an allowance or benefit being paid to the	34
subsequent survivors of the former member.	35
The date of the first increase under this section becomes	36
the anniversary date for any future increases.	37
The allowance or benefit used in the first calculation of	38
an increase under this section shall remain as the base for all	39
future increases, unless a new base is established. Any increase	40
resulting from payment of a recalculated benefit under Section 3	41
of Substitute Senate Bill No. 270 of the 123rd general assembly	42
shall be included in the calculation of future increases under	43
this section.	44
(B) If payment of a portion of a benefit is made to an	45
alternate payee under section 3309.671 of the Revised Code,	46
increases under this section granted while the order is in	47
effect shall be apportioned between the alternate payee and the	48

retirant or disability benefit recipient in the same proportion	49
that the amount being paid to the alternate payee bears to the	50
amount paid to the retirant or disability benefit recipient.	51
If payment of a portion of a benefit is made to one or	52
more beneficiaries under "plan F" under division (B)(3)(e) of	53
section 3309.46 of the Revised Code, each increase under this	54
section granted while the plan of payment is in effect shall be	55
divided among the designated beneficiaries in accordance with	56
the portion each beneficiary has been allocated.	57
(C) The board shall make all rules necessary to carry out	58
