Opposition to proposed changes to immunization exemptions and tracking processes

Good morning. My name is Kara Brown I am a stay at home mother of four children, their ages range from 1 to 9 years old. I would like to tell you my reasons I oppose HB 559. I am very concerned about the tracking of my children's vaccination status and the information being made public, and that this bill would require me to get a medical education to obtain my religious exemption.

In 2017 my children were kicked out of their pediatrician's office of 8 years when I told the pediatrician I would not be vaccinating because of my religious beliefs. She proceeded to tell me that their policy had changed and if I did not vaccinate my children we were no longer welcomed at their office. I was given no options, it was either vaccinate or go somewhere else. My children's current pediatrician also asked why I was not vaccinating and after I had told her my religious views she commented "praying won't protect your child."

A doctor is not qualified to determine religious matters. To require me to get a medical education is putting a doctor between God and myself.

Doctors do not know my sincere religious beliefs. That my children and I were created in Gods Image (Genesis 1:27) and he made us perfect (Genesis 1:31), he made our immune systems perfect and the way our bodies work perfect.
