RE: Proponent – HB 500 Tax Increment Financing (TIFs) Enacted Prior to July 1994

Dear Chair Anielski:

Thank you for this opportunity to provide written testimony in favor of House Bill 500 regarding Tax Increment Financing (TIF). My name is Vicky Earhart and I serve as Township Administrator for Anderson Township (Hamilton County, Ohio).

Almost 45,000 citizens reside in Anderson Township, a limited home rule urban township located on the eastern border of the City of Cincinnati. Over the years, TIFs have played a key role in shaping Anderson into one of the most desirable places to live and work in the Greater Cincinnati region. TIFs are crucial to providing funding for public infrastructure improvements which, in turn help to attract and retain businesses. I come before you today in support of HB 500 which would permit the use of those same TIF dollars for continued maintenance of the significant investment that has been made in public infrastructure.

In the mid-2000's, TIF funding was utilized to pay for a large portion of the demolition of an aging mall resulting in the newly developed Anderson Towne Center. Adjacent to this development, TIF dollars were utilized to fund Anderson Center, a multi-purpose facility which serves as a hub for both Township government services and as a multi-faceted venue for civic, arts, commerce, and communications organizations. Anderson Center and the revitalized shopping center sparked the rebirth of the heart of our community which benefitted from more than \$165 million in private and public investment within a half mile radius in the last two years (see attached). This infusion is one of the reasons why Anderson Township was named as one of the "WCPO Places to Watch in 2016."

TIF dollars were also used to fund implementation of the award-winning Beechmont Corridor Plan which included traffic flow and safety improvements along Beechmont Avenue, the Township's primary retail corridor. Enhancement included landscaping, curbing, cross-access roadways between properties (known as Anderson Accessways), additional sidewalks, improved crosswalks, turning lanes and address number signage all of which made it safer and easier for customers to patronize local businesses.

The use of TIF funds has not been limited to our central core. In 2014, TIF dollars were used for demolition of the former River Downs Racetrack along our southern border making way for one of the state's seven racinos. Belterra Park Gaming and Entertainment Center, Coney Island, and Riverbend Music Center now form the central hub of Anderson's Ohio Riverfront Entertainment District. TIF revenues from Belterra Park are being used to enhance transportation and public infrastructure in the entertainment district fostering further economic development.

Neighborhood business districts have also benefitted from TIF dollars which have provided funding for transportation enhancements including additional turn lanes, improved driveways, utility consolidation, landscaping, stormwater improvements, and lighting. In addition, more than 20 miles of TIF-funded sidewalks have been installed along county roadways. This program known as Anderson Trails has connected neighborhoods to shopping, medical facilities, recreation, schools, and the library.

Anderson has successfully utilized TIFs to build a strong viable community with a high quality of life which inures to the benefit of all property owners. TIFs are crucial to providing funding for public infrastructure improvements which, in turn help to attract and retain businesses. Their effectiveness has been proven and is significant. HB 500 would ensure that the investments that have been made in public infrastructure improvements through TIFs are preserved by allowing the use of those same dollars for continued maintenance.
