Good morning Chairman Oelslager, Vice-Chair Manning, Ranking Member Skindell, and Members of the Senate Finance Committee. My name is Dianne Farabi, Executive Director of the Ohio Orthotics and Prosthetics Association.

I regret that I am not able to testify in person due to scheduled foot surgery.

We would like to commend and thank this distinguished body of Senators for restoring licensure for Orthotic, Prosthetic and Pedorthic (O, P & P) practitioners in the latest version of Sub HB49. This has occurred through the formation of a new **State Physical Health Services Board.**

We join with the patients who receive OP&P services and care, their physicians, families, and other stakeholders who understand the significance of licensure, to support its restoration.

OP & P represents a small but significant segment of health care, not generally regarded or understand until an individual, family member, colleague, or friend loses mobility due to limb loss, disease or trauma. With their very specialized advanced education and training, O P & P practitioners work with physicians and other members of a physical rehabilitation team to restore mobility to ultimately save lives and money.

A recent analysis of Medicare data shows timely O&P patient care saves Medicare \$231 million annually compared with costs associated with same diagnosis patients who did not receive O&P services and developed co-morbidities resulting in higher Medicare costs.
