Hi my name is Kristina Andrews and I reside in Cleveland, OH. As the mother of two boys I recall learning of each pregnancy around the seventh week. From my experience with healthcare providers, past physicians did not want to see me as an ultrasound patient until week eight, which left me at the mercies of emergency rooms to administer urine tests, blood work, and biased consultations regarding my pregnancies.
