BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, Mental health, including behavioral health,	3
substance use, and psychological well-being, is at the forefront	4
of public health as an essential and integral component of the	5
overall health and well-being of individuals and populations;	6

WHEREAS, According to the National Alliance on Mental	8
Illness:	9
Approximately 44 million adults in the United States, or	10
roughly one in five adults, experience mental illness;	11
Approximately twenty-six per cent of homeless adults in	12
shelters in the United States live with serious mental illness;	13
Approximately twenty-four per cent of state prisoners in	14
the United States have a recent history of a mental condition;	15

Suicide is the tenth leading cause of death worldwide,	16
and ninety per cent of those who die by suicide have an	17
underlying mental illness; and	18
WHEREAS, According to the National Institute of Mental	19
Health, nearly sixty per cent of adults with mental illness in	20
the United States did not receive treatment for their mental	21
illness in the previous year; and	22
WHEREAS, According to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health	23
Services Administration, Ohio ranks twelfth in prevalence of	24
mental illness in adults; and	25
WHEREAS, According to the National Council for Behavioral	26
Health, Ohio has one of the highest rates of drug-related deaths	27
and opioid addiction in the United States; now therefore be it	28
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 132nd General	29
Assembly of the State of Ohio, support those individuals in our	30
state who are struggling with mental illness; and be it further	31
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 132nd General	32
Assembly of the State of Ohio, encourage efforts to increase	33
public awareness about mental illness and the availability of	34
mental health treatment and services for Ohio citizens; and be	35

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Senate transmit duly	37
authenticated copies of this resolution to the Governor, the	38
Director of the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction	39
