A BILL

To amend section 4511.84 of the Revised Code to	1
permit a person to wear earphones or earplugs	2
for hearing protection while operating a	3
motorcycle.	4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4511.84 of the Revised Code be	5
amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4511.84. (A) No person shall operate a motor vehicle	7
while wearing earphones over, or earplugs in, both ears. As used	8
in this section , "earphones" <u>:</u>	9
<u>(1) "Earphones" means any headset, radio, tape player, or</u>	10
other similar device that <u>covers all or a portion of both ears</u>	11
and that does either of the following:	12
(a) Through either a physical connection to another device	13
or a wireless connection, provides the listener with radio	14

programs, music, or other recorded information through a device	15
attached to the head and that covers all or a portion of both-	16
ears <u>;</u>	17
(b) Provides hearing protection. "Earphones"	18
"Earphones" does not include speakers or other listening	19
devices that are built into protective headgear.	20
(2) "Earplugs" means any device that can be inserted into	21
one or both ears and that does either of the following:	22
(a) Through either a physical connection to another device	23
or a wireless connection, provides the listener with radio	24
programs, music, or other information;	25
(b) Provides hearing protection.	26
(B) No person shall operate a motor vehicle while wearing	27
earphones over, or earplugs in, both ears.	28
(C) This section does not apply to:	29
(1) Any person wearing a hearing aid;	30
(2) Law enforcement personnel while on duty;	31
(3) Fire department personnel and emergency medical	32
service personnel while on duty;	33
(4) Any person engaged in the operation of equipment for	34
use in the maintenance or repair of any highway;	35
(5) Any person engaged in the operation of refuse	36
collection equipment <u>;</u>	37
(6) Any person wearing earphones or earplugs for hearing	38
protection while operating a motorcycle.	39

If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has	42
been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one predicate motor	43
vehicle or traffic offense, whoever violates this section is	44

year of the offense, the offender previously has been convicted	46
of two or more predicate motor vehicle or traffic offenses,	47
whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the	48
