BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3101.08, 3101.10, 3101.11, and	5
3101.12 of the Revised Code be amended to read as follows:	6
Sec. 3101.08. An ordained or licensed minister of any	7
religious society or congregation within this state who is-	8
licensed to solemnize marriages, a judge of a county court in	9
accordance with section 1907.18 of the Revised Code, a judge of	10
a municipal court in accordance with section 1901.14 of the	11
Revised Code, a probate judge in accordance with section 2101.27	12
of the Revised Code, the mayor of a municipal corporation in any	13
county in which such municipal corporation wholly or partly	14
lies, the superintendent of the state school for the deaf, or	15
any religious society in conformity with the rules of its	16
church, The following persons or entities may join together as	17
husband and wife any persons who are not prohibited by law from	18

being joined in marriage:	19
(A) An ordained or licensed minister of any religious	20
society or congregation within this state who is licensed to	21
solemnize marriages;	22
(B) A judge of a county court in accordance with section	23
1907.18 of the Revised Code;	24
(C) A judge of a municipal court in accordance with	25
section 1901.14 of the Revised Code;	26
(D) A probate judge in accordance with section 2101.27 of	27

(E) The mayor of a municipal corporation in any county in	29

(H) Any other person or entity that has registered to	34
solemnize marriages with the secretary of state.	35
Sec. 3101.10. (A) A minister upon producing to the	36
secretary of state, credentials of the minister's being a	37
regularly ordained or licensed minister of any religious society	38
or congregation, shall be entitled to receive from the secretary	39
of state a license authorizing the minister to solemnize	4 C
marriages in this state so long as the minister continues as a	41
regular minister in that society or congregation. A minister	42
shall produce for inspection the minister's license to solemnize	43
marriages upon demand of any party to a marriage at which the	44
minister officiates or proposes to officiate or upon demand of	45
any probate judge.	46

(B) Any other person or entity that wishes to solemnize	47		
marriages shall register with the secretary of state and the	48		
secretary of state shall issue a license authorizing the person	49		
or entity to solemnize marriages in this state. The person shall	50		
produce for inspection the person's license to solemnize	51		
marriages or, if applicable, the license of the entity on behalf	52		
of which the person is solemnizing marriages, upon demand of any			
party to a marriage at which the person officiates or proposes	54		
to officiate or upon demand of any probate judge.	55
