(B) Not later than ninety days after the effective date of	39
this section, the registrar of motor vehicles shall establish a	40
permanent driver's license reinstatement fee debt reduction and	41
amnesty program.	42
(C) Under the program, both of the following apply:	43
(1) A person whose driver's license or permit has been	44
suspended as a result of an eligible offense may apply to the	45

registrar for driver's license reinstatement fee debt reduction	46
if the person has completed all court-ordered sanctions related	47
to the eligible offense other than the payment of reinstatement	48
fees and at least eighteen months have expired since the end of	4 9
the period of suspension ordered by the court.	50
(2) A person whose driver's license or permit has been	51
suspended as a result of an eligible offense may apply to the	52
registrar for complete amnesty if the person has completed all	53
court-ordered sanctions related to the eligible offense other	54
than the payment of reinstatement fees, and the person is	55
indigent and can demonstrate proof of indigence by providing	56
documentation in a form approved by the registrar.	57
(D)(1) The registrar shall grant reinstatement fee debt	58
reduction to a person who is eligible under division (C)(1) of	59
this section as follows:	60
(a) If the person owes reinstatement fees for multiple	61
eligible offenses, the person shall be required to pay either	62
the lowest reinstatement fee owed for those offenses or ten per	63
cent of the total amount owed for those offenses, whichever	64
amount is greater.	65
(b) If the person owes reinstatement fees for one eligible	66
offense, the person shall be required to pay one-half of the	67
reinstatement fee owed for that offense.	68
(2) The registrar shall grant complete amnesty to a person	69
eligible under division (C)(2) of this section.	70
(E) (1) If the registrar denies an application under the	71
program, the registrar shall provide an explanation in writing	72
to the applicant that states the reason the application was	73
denied	7.4

(2) If an application is denied, the applicant may request	75
an administrative hearing to appeal the denial or may reapply	76
for the program. Any decision made by the registrar on appeal is	77
final. An applicant shall not reapply for the program more than	78
once a year. The registrar shall establish the parameters for	79
the administrative appeals process by rule.	80
(F) The registrar shall conduct public service	81
announcements regarding the permanent driver's license	82
reinstatement fee debt reduction and amnesty program that	83
includes a description of the program and its requirements. In	84
addition, the registrar shall make such information available on	85
the bureau of motor vehicle's web site.	86
(G) The registrar shall adopt rules in accordance with	87
Chapter 119. of the Revised Code in order to establish any	88
requirements and procedures necessary to administer and	89
implement this section.	90
